CITY UPDATES

Downtown Strategic Plan Important Meeting - May 9

The Lafayette City Council will be holding an important all day meeting on May 9, at Stanley Middle School beginning at 9:00am. This meeting is a continuation of their April 13th meeting that included all the commissions, committees and consultants working on this two year old project. All the groups involved have provided the city and city council with their recommendations for changes to the Draft Plan. At this meeting the city council will review their changes and listen to public comment. At the April board meeting, your Lafayette Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors voted to support in general the concepts proposed in the Draft Strategic Plan with the amendments made by the Advisory Committee. The board will be submitting some specifics to the city council before the meeting on May 9. To review all the material submitted to the city, please visit www.ci.lafayette.ca.us. Lafayette Circle Utility Undergrounding Project

The second phase of this project has begun. All Day Electric Company, working with PG&E, will begin cutting into the street and sidewalks. A one lane traffic control plan will be utilized daily between 8:00am - 5:00pm. No parking signs will be posted on the street prior to the crews working in specific areas. The first holes to be dug will be right outside the Chamber office on the corner of Lafayette Circle and Hough. The good news is this project is ahead of schedule and should be complete before the end of the summer.

Oakwood Athletic Club recently added a gymnastic class for children with special needs to its Kids Exercise Programs. Members approached management in January 2008 and requested a class that specifically addressed the needs of children with disabilities. Although many of these children were still attending regular classes, management noticed that there was an opportunity to give extra attention to help them succeed. Oakwood's Kid Exercise Manager, Jessica Ho, worked closely with parents to create a class that would be appropriate and fun for the children and would also be convenient to attend. By June 2008, Oakwood was pleased to add Adaptive Gymnastics to its Kids program. Becky Correll and Nichole Milliman were chosen as instructors for the class because of their valued experience and qualifications.

In this small class setting, the children have flourished. Instructors and parents alike are able to enjoy each little success as the children develop. The class includes typical social activities such as student participation, sharing, and etiquette. Some of the more complex developmental activities include forward rolls, walking the balance beam, and hanging on the bars. These children have become friends and give each other hugs in greeting and farewell. Recently, Oakwood was able to open this special class to the community. Oakwood has been greatly enriched in getting to know and helping more of these special children. The mothers of these children have been able to form unique friendships. They come together to share advice, joy, and frustrations. They understand each other in a way that many others do not and appreciate the time the children spend in the class.

Oakwood also hosted a KEEN event in November of 2008. KEEN, Kids Enjoy Exercise Now, is a national, nonprofit volunteer organization that provides one-on-one recreational opportunities for children with mental and physical disabilities. Oakwood was able to donate their gymnasium space for an afternoon of individual interaction and play for both Oakwood members and children throughout the community.
